Competition Notes from Mark Gromko, N4C president

Greetings N4C members!

I write at the beginning of a new “photo-year” for N4C, and look forward to the many images and experiences we will share through club activities, N4C contests, and conventions.

Last year saw several rule changes, one of which is the addition of an alternate judging metric that may be used instead of the familiar T,C,I metric. (That is, judging clubs may choose to use one or the other of these two ways to judge photos.) The second is a revision and reorganization of the Definitions and Rules for contest categories. Everyone in N4C should become familiar with these changes, but especially anyone submitting photos for competition or those participating as judges.

I will be writing about each of these changes in the monthly Bulletin, but information on both topics is currently available on the N4C Web site. Just click on the big blue button labeled “N4C Contest Rules” at the top of the Competition Page (<http://www.n4c.us/competition.htm>). See F-2 through F-3 for descriptions of the two judging metrics (of which judging clubs may choose to use either one). See F-5 through F-6 of the Handbook for the changes to Definitions and Rules for competition categories.

If you have questions about either of these topics, or any other issues, please contact me (mgromko@bgsu.edu), other members of the Board, Contest Chairs, or other N4C officers. Communication among club members, among clubs, and between clubs and N4C officers is essential for the smooth functioning of our clubs. This Directory is designed to help you find contact information for people you would like to communicate with. Use it well and often!

Please be sure to read the recent rewrite of the definitions and rules for the competition categories! Whether you submit photos to our monthly competitions, participate in judging, or simply are an interested observer, you will want to be familiar with the changes and reorganization of the definitions and rules.

One of the main features of the revision is an increase in clarity and ease of use. Where there were separate sections for “definitions” and “rules” before, these have now been combined into a single section. The revised section can be found on pages F-5 through F-6 of the Handbook.

Among the substantive changes, “Color Prints” has been renamed “Pictorial Prints,” so that each of the six competition categories (Journalism, Nature, Travel, Pictorial, Black & White, and Altered Reality) now has a digital and a print competition. The definition of Travel has been refined slightly, removing the bias toward “distant” or “exotic” places. The definition of Pictorial has also been updated and coordinated with the definition of Black & White.

There was formerly a list of “allowable adjustments” for all digital categories. That list has been replaced with a brief paragraph under Statement of Ethics (item 4, page F-1); more detailed statements about adjustments are now included within each category, making clear that different adjustments are appropriate for different categories. The categories are in order from fewest adjustments allowed to most allowed (Journalism, Nature, Travel, Pictorial, Black & White, and Altered Reality) on pages F-5 through F-6.

We hope you find the revision makes the definitions and rules of competition categories easier to understand, use, and apply.

Phil Gilman, 92, Topeka, Kansas, passed away June 27, 2019, at Brookdale Topeka Memory Care Facility.

Phil was born January 27, 1927, in Topeka, the son of John and Frances Vollrath Gilman. He graduated from Topeka High School and received his Civil Engineer Degree from KU after serving two years in the United States Army during WWII. Phil spent one year in Okinawa. He worked for KDOT for 35 years. Phil met Elizabeth, the love of his life, on the Saturday Morning Bike Ride on July 20, 1974. He planned the first Cottonwood 200 Bike Ride. Phil helped with the routing of the first Biking Across Kansas in 1975. Phil proposed to Elizabeth in Sterling, halfway across the first BAK. They were married on the porch of the Ward-Meade Home on July 20, 1975. They went on many bike trips, seven times on BAK, from Topeka to Kalamazoo, Cape Cod, Denmark, etc. After retirement, it was time to buy a motor home to visit grandchildren in New Jersey and Texas, as well as the National Parks. They made it to all states except Hawaii. Phil took up photography again and put together many beautiful slide shows.

Phil is survived by his wife, Elizabeth; daughter, Jeanine Roberts (Tom), Flemington, New Jersey; granddaughter, Kerianne Johnson (David), Houston, Texas; grandsons, John and Christian, Topeka, and Josiah, Flemington; step-son, Bill McLeod, Fort Worth, Texas; step-granddaughter, Shayla Beard (Ricky); and two step-great-granddaughters, Morgan and Reagon, Odessa, Texas. He was preceded in death by his son, John.

Celebration of Phil's life will be 11 a.m. Wednesday, July 17, 2019, at Lowman United Methodist Church, 4101 SW 15th Street, Topeka KS 66604. Phil's body was donated to KU Med Center for Alzheimer Research.

We sent Elizabeth a condolence card, because it never is too late to express your sympathy. Phil was such a special person; and over the years, the Gilmans added so much to N4C. This lovely letter from Elizabeth arrived today, and I do not think she would mind if I share it with you:

Dear Pat and Gene,


Thank you for the lovely card and note. Phil did so enjoy the N4C group. He began fading in 2007 with Alzheimers. It is a wicked disease. He had to give up driving and photography. I was able to care for him until July 9, 2016, when he fell and had to go to the hospital, got a pacemaker, in rehab for 3 months, and by this time he could not walk, even with a walker, so there was no way to care for him at home.

I found Brookdale Home for Alzheimer's patients only 2 miles from my house. He had loving care there and died peacefully after lunch on June 28, 2019. I was so glad I had made some good investments in the stock market to help pay the \$7,000 monthly fee.

I am doing okay with my duplicate bridge and church friends and good neighbors. I plan to stay here as long as I can drive, as I have a well-built house, good neighbors, a garage, a walk-in tub, and it is close to my activities.

Tell all the old timers of N4C that I miss seeing them, and check the winners every month.
