# President's Corner – April 2013

Well Springbrook 2013 is history. My thanks go out to Diane for arranging the weekend program, to Deloris and Larry for handling the reservations, accommodations and food. What a weekend it was, when I got in the car Friday AM, I had the heat on, but before I pulled into Springbrook, the A/C was on. Beautiful temperatures all weekend long and a beautiful drive home, to another round of sNOw.

On a brief N4C business note:

- The digital advisory committee will be looking at defining the screen size/resolution, computer settings, color and brightness setting and more, as we had a long discussion on how one clubs projector and screen makes the images appear under-exposed or hotspots or the color was off. With the inroads made with large flat screen TV's, it only appears right to let clubs judge using a large flat screen TV or monitor. I remember years back, there was an article or instruction for 'calibrating' a slide judging, where the projector was setup to fill the screen and an SLR, with 50 mm lens were used to measure the white light reflection from the screen and at a given ASA and aperture, the shutter speed should fall between this and that. If it did not the projector was to be moved in or out or switched from low to high power, until the range was met.
- Another discussion centered around 'locale' in the title for travel images, this was part on my last month's Presidents Corner and I have asked that the travel chairs include a definition as what is expected as 'locale'. I've taken 'locale' as to mean, I could find the location or close to it and repeat the shot.
- On the same note, how much, if any 'hand of man' can be in a nature image? Birds rest on fence posts or fence wires and those are 'hand of man', but a wild animal walking down a busy city street, is that too much? The rules allow zoo or captive shots, provided that it looks NATURAL. Communication and definition is what is needed from the judging chairs, so look for it starting in September.

The Southwest Iowa Shutterbugs, in Creston, Iowa has a well-planned fall convention planned for all of us. Starting Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup> with a trail ride, bonfire and hot dog roast, Friday is another day for getting out and about and capturing "Treasures from the area" and the Best of N4C. Saturday brings together a great collection of speakers and makes you choose which session you want to attend. If you didn't get a promo disc at Springbrook, it's now available on the web - <u>http://n4c.us/index.html</u>

Speakers include: Parish Kohanim (Canon Explores of Light), N4C own Ty Smede, Mark Petersen (nature), Ryan Brown (Sigma rep) and a rep from Tamron, as well as the Keynote speaker – Tim Abramowitz. You will only be able to hear 4 of the 6 speakers, as a couple of sessions have dual options. Great program Southwest Iowa Shutterbugs and thanks for volunteering to host the 2013 Convention.
