I encouraged her to go purchase a little hard drive and copy her images for back up immediately because to lose these would truly be losing an important part of their lives. Purchasing a little hard drive for a loved one as a present might preserve photos of the special people in your lives. I see the same thing with my college students who take a photography course from me when I ask "where are your backups?" The last few years only one of the 18 enrolled has had a backup in place and most photos are on cell phones. As an aside, one morning last fall I had the plumber here first thing in the morning who finished my job and then was headed for the downtown bars in Iowa City. When I asked him about the bars: he has a contract to remove cell phones from toilets every day of the week! (who knew?) So if your images or those of someone you love aren't backed up - do it now! As I've said before the only thing about technology is that it is guaranteed to fail at some point.

Image quality

Our club judged digital pictorial this month and I just have to reflect on the quality of the images submitted. Although my time as a member of N4C has been a hiccough compared to some of you reading this I am truly amazed at the overall quality of the images and how much it has changed even in the last few years. It used to be a photograph of a bird with a good depth of field had a great chance of winning but now it's almost as though the bird should be "doing the funky chicken" or some such thing to be eligible to win. Many of the N4C clubs have spent time with their new members helping them understand what makes a good image, practice and how to try and achieve the results other successful club members have in our various contests through critique nights of new member images.

Filters

In this digital age we are able to crop and make all sorts of adjustments to an image, some good and some not so good, to be honest, and it's easy to get carried away with some of the filters available to us. Speaking of filters Google bought the company that makes Nik Filters (my personal favorites) and are now giving them away for free! (https://www.google.com/nikcollection/) I would encourage anyone to download them and use them as they work with Adobe Lightroom, Adobe Photoshop Elements and Adobe Photoshop. Another set of filters many of us like are the Topaz filters https://www.topazlabs.com/ I'm very much a rookie with these filters but have plans that this summer I will learn to used them. For those of you who have looked at the creative category there is one that kind of looks like electricity on an image that looks like fun.

Although the Nik filters have a filter for noise (Define 2) that comes with the bundle I personally prefer another filter called Imagenomic-> Noiseware.

Secure the loose print to the stiff backing by either double sided tape-across the top edge of the print or hinge them along the top edge so the original print tag can be seen.
