I hope everyone is having a great fall. Peak color is done here in the Northland and the birds are migrating South. Between work and school, my nose has been to the grindstone, however; I did take some time out to photograph some Fall color on a day trip to central Wisconsin. Another day trip up to Crex Meadows in Northern Wisconsin fortuitously coincided with the Sandhill crane migration. That gave me a chance to practice following birds in flight silhouetted against the setting sun.

For those in the Southern part of N4C land, these photo ops are headed your way. Most states now do a Fall color map. If your time is limited like mine, that gives a great predictor for which direction to head when you have a chance to get out. Rain or shine, don't forget that polarizer! Fall



leaves tend to be shiny, a polarizer will help cut through the glare for more saturated color. Another great resource are the staff at natural areas. Information staff at Crex were able to tell me not only that the cranes were coming through, but where they liked to land and when--they even pointed out a great parking spot for silhouettes against the sun and told me what time they start to come into their favorite night roost-



ing spot. If you want to avoid pictures of bird's backsides, pay attention to wind direction. Large birds prefer to take off and land into the wind. Keep the wind to your back and you'll be in a great position as they come in to land. Happy hunting.


