At the spring Board Meeting, we passed a revision to the rules and definitions for the monthly competitions. The main point of the revision is to clarify and simplify the presentation of the rules and definitions. The following should be noted by all competitors and judges.

- 1. The "rules" and "definitions" were separate before; these have now been combined in a single section.
- 2. The "Color Prints" competition has been renamed "Pictorial Prints." Thus, each of the six competition categories (Journalism, Nature, Travel, Pictorial, Black & White, and Altered Reality) now has a digital competition and a print competition.
- 3. "Pictorial" and "Black & White" categories are similar in character; color images should be submitted to "Pictorial" and monochrome images should be submitted to "Black & White."
- 4. There was formerly a list of "allowable adjustments" for all digital categories. That list has been eliminated; each category now identifies limitations on adjustments appropriate to that category.

The revised rules and definitions have been incorporated into the Handbook. We urge all competitors and judges to read the updated material.
